

## Golden Arrow District 2005 Honor Unit Requirements

*The GAD Honor Unit Award was created in 2003 to recognize those GAD Packs, Troops, Teams, Crews, and Ships that conduct a quality Scouting program in a manner that support the District's efforts to earn the National Quality District Award and to meet the goals set by the Council in the areas of Membership, Finance and Program. Qualifying as a GAD Honor Unit is recognized by a limited-edition temporary patch for each of the unit's officially registered members (both youth and adult) as of December 31 of the year for which the award is earned. Patches are usually expected to be available at District Dinner.*

### Unit Standard

- Quality Unit 2005
- 100% Boys Life 2005

### Friends of Scouting Standard

- Turn in 2006 FOS Unit Coordinator contact information<sup>‡</sup> and date for 2006 presentation by the deadline given in the 2005-6 GAD Calendar
- Family FOS 2006 Unit Coordinator attends training on the date announced in the 2005-6 GAD Calendar

### Unit Planning Standard

- Turn in the unit's 2005-6 IYOS family newsletter and 2005-6 Calendar at September 2005 Roundtable

### Unit Fundraising Standard

- Sell an average of \$50 of Popcorn per Scout based on August 1, 2005, Council membership report
- Participate in Scout Fair with a booth and sell Scout Fair tickets in 2005
- Turn in Scout Fair Ticket Sales Coordinator contact information<sup>‡</sup> by February 2005 Roundtable

### Training Standard

- Ensure 50% of registered adults are "trained for their current position" by December 1, 2005
- Attend 6 or more Roundtables in 2005

### Public Relations Standard

- Publish 9 or more Scouting publicity articles about your unit [newspaper articles, announcements, web pages, TV coverage, church bulletins, and marquee announcements] in 2005

### Membership Standard

- Hold a Spring recruiting rally before April 25, 2005
- Turn in Membership Recruiting Coordinator (School Night To Join Scouting Coordinator for Packs, various other positions for other unit types) contact information<sup>‡</sup> by June 2005 Roundtable
- Membership Recruiting Coordinator attends SNTJS training session in August 2005
- Conduct a Fall recruiting event by September 15, 2005

### Program Standard

- Attend long-term Summer Camp specific for your program area, i.e., Twilight Camp, Cub Scout Resident Camp, Boy Scout Summer Camp, and Crew in 2005
- Participate in a non-Scout-sponsored public event as a unit (e.g., march in a community parade) in 2005
- Participate in a Council or District event for your program in 2005
- Conduct a minimum of 6 unit level special outings / events during 2005 (Council and District events count)
